Overview

Johnson Controls has confirmed the presence of a vulnerable version of Log4J, which may be exposed via exacq Enterprise Manager. Enterprise Manager customers are encouraged to upgrade to the latest exacq release to prevent any remote code execution. Alternatively, there is a work around that can be applied in the short term.

### **Impact**

An attacker could enter malicious input and potentially allow remote code execution.

### **Affected Versions**

All versions of exacq Enterprise Manager up to and including version 21.12

# Mitigation

- Upgrade exacq Enterprise Manager to version 21.12.1.
   -or-
- Apply manual mitigation steps (available on request)
